You can effect your payment by logging in to your account and completing the renewal process on www.mipa.mu.

Exempt members still need to complete the renewal form electronically and send it to MIPA Secretariat with a proof of employment certifying that the member is employed by the Government, a local authority under the Local Government Act 2011, or the Rodrigues Regional Assembly under the Rodrigues Regional Assembly Act.

Failure to renew the membership will automatically remove the member from the register of members as from 16 November 2020 and members will be liable to a re-admission fee in addition to any outstanding fees.
